Paradox between training and use of educational managers in Vietnam

Management education is one of the weaknesses of the education sector in Vietnam. Vietnam has about 14,000 education managers, but more than half of those not fluent in professional management education. The training of staff education management to meet the needs of education today as well as future development is an urgent need. Some universities and professional organizations are currently training staff management education. However, the relationship between training and use has been inadequate. The paper will analyze the situation and recommendations for improvement.
