Besides her regular job, Dr. Vu is actively involved in the activities of Vietnam's Private Universities and Colleges Association to promote quality management activities in private higher education institutions in Vietnam, being one of the three founders of the Educational Quality Training and Support Center (EQTS). She also continues her teaching and thesis supervision at post-graduate levels on quality management in higher education.
