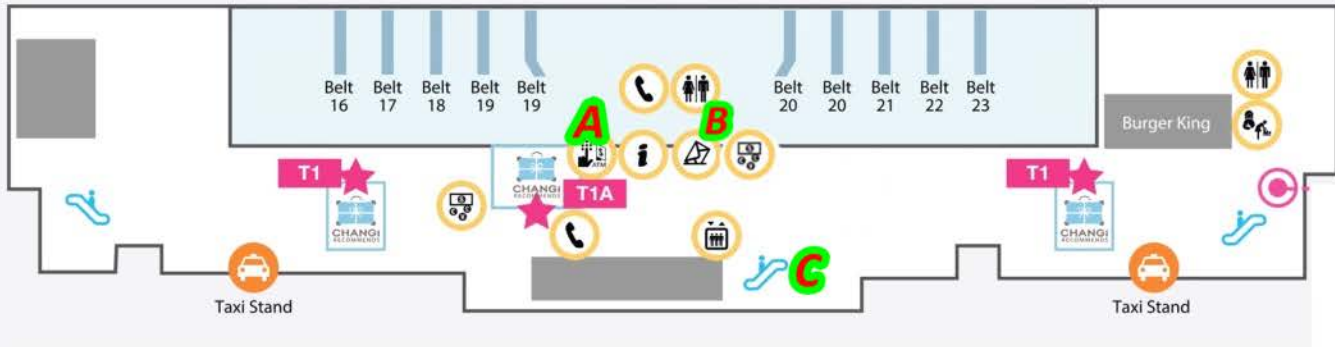

Skytrain in Terminal 1 to MRT at Terminal 3, then Hotel Grand Pacific Hotel, Singapore

SINGAPORE CHANGI AIRPORT TERMINAL 1 - ARRIVAL HALL, LEVEL 1 (PUBLIC AREA)



In the centre of Terminal 1, you will find

- A) The UOB bank that you can have currency exchange;
- B) The Changi Airport counter. You can:

- i) buy 5-GB store value phone and data sim card(s). (SGD50 each)
- ii) arrange limo/ private car transfer. (Each ride costs SGD30)



Look for this sign when you arrive the Terminal 3.

Keep walking for 3-4 minutes, take the escalator, turn right and take another escalator to the lower floor where you will find the MRT station.



Look for this sign and take the free "Skytrain" to Terminal 3 of the Changi Airport.
(Terminal 1 of the Changi airport does not have MRT station.)

Please refer to the guides on page 2 for taking MRT to the Bras Basha Station.

The Roundtable Designated Hotel is 5-min walk from the MRT station.
(see Page 3 for directions to the Hotel by foot.)

Taking MRT from Changi Airport to Designated Hotel

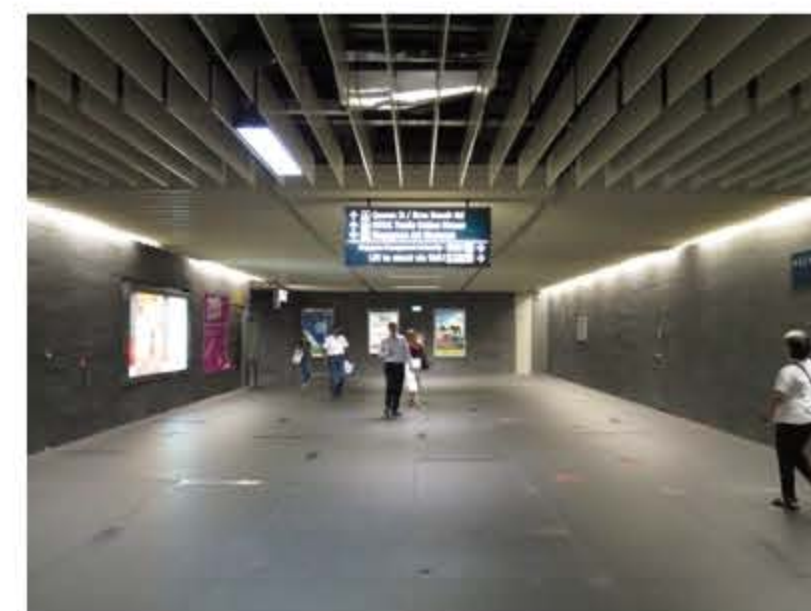
Fare: SGD 1.89

- 1** Taking "East West Line" at Changi Airport
- 2** Transfer at Tanah Merah Station (Joo Koon Direction)
- 3** Transit to "Circle Line" at Paya Lebar Station
- 4** Taking "Circle Line" (Dhoby Ghaut Direction) at Paya Lebar Station
→ Bras Basah Station



Directions: Bras Basah Station to Hotel Grand Pacific, Singapore

5 Take Exit "A" when you arrive the Bras Basah Station (You find those Signs at the Station.)



6 Turn "Right" when you get back to the ground and you will see the sign "NTUC Trade Union House".

7 Walk for LESS THAN 1 MIN., you will see the Main Entrance of "NTUC Trade Union House". Then you turn "Left".



8 You will now see this street.



9 Keep walking for around 1 MIN., you will see the Carlton Hotel. Then turn "Left".



10 You will then see this street.



11 Walk for around 1 MIN., and you will pass by "Steakout" and "7-Eleven".

Then you will see the "Hotel Grand Pacific, Singapore".
