## **Terms of Reference**

1. To investigate and decide on any appeal by a student against the decision of the Student Disciplinary Committee or the Board of Examiners for his/her discontinuation of studies.
2. To investigate and decide on any appeal against the decision of the Equal Opportunities Complaint Committee on the case(s) in which the Respondent is a student.
3. To cancel, alter or impose additional penalties as it deems appropriate on the student(s) appealing against the decision of a student disciplinary case.
4. To decide whether the student should be required to discontinue his or her studies for a case where the student is appealing against the decision of a Board of Examiners and to recommend appropriate measures if the decision is to allow the student to continue.
5. To decide whether or not to adopt the findings and recommendations of the Equal Opportunities Complaint Committee, and to decide on the appropriate course of action, as deemed necessary.
6. To inform the Board of Examiners or the Student Disciplinary Committee or the Equal Opportunities Complaint Committee concerned and the student concerned as soon as possible of its decision and recommendations.
7. To report to the President at such intervals as the President may decide.
